Installation and activation

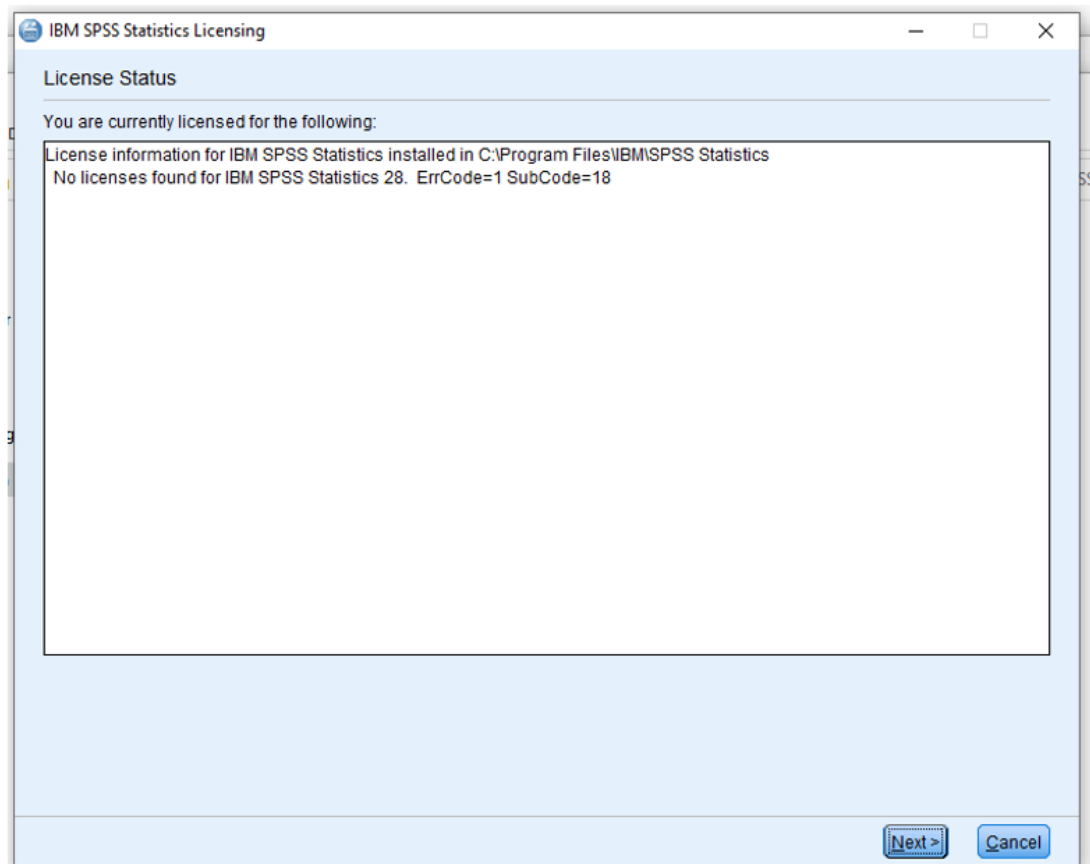

VPN must always be used in order to start/check out a SPSS license. Start and login to the VPN every time you wish to run SPSS.

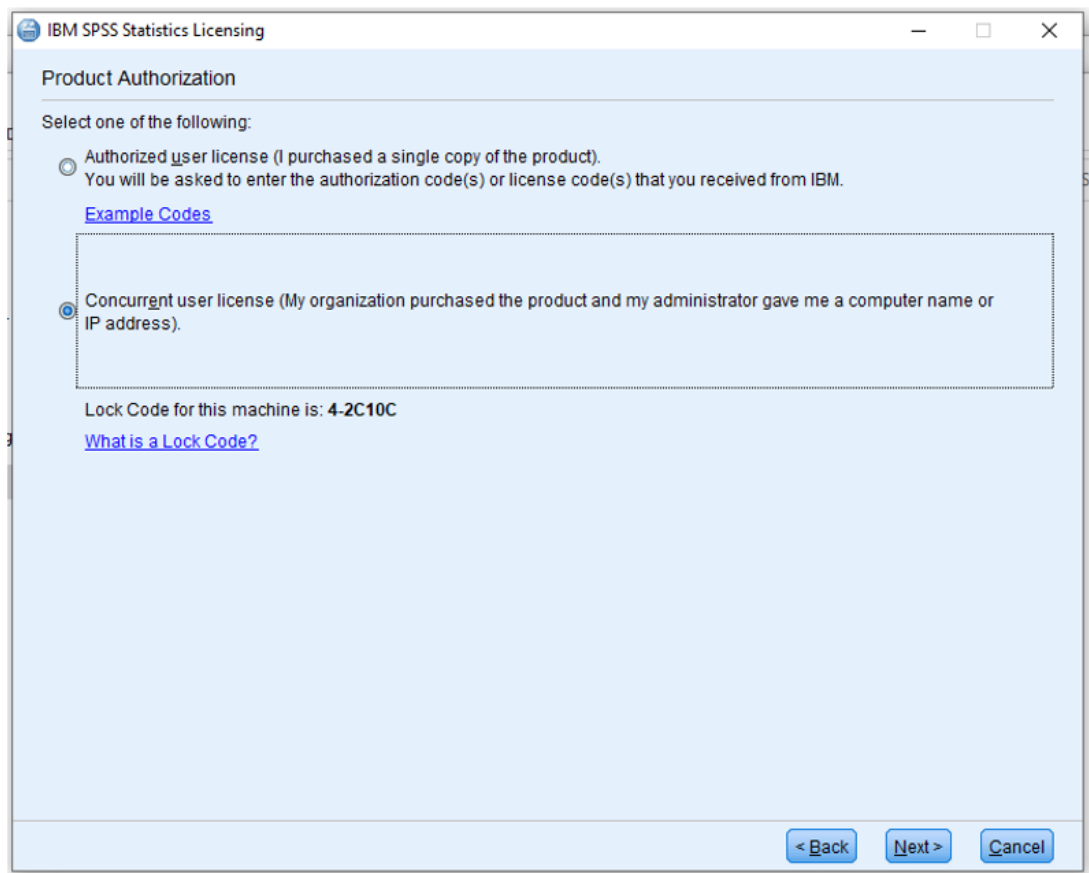
- You can now download SPSS installation files from the [Download portal](#) (a JU account is needed for access to downloads)
- Install the software by following the instructions on the screen
- When SPSS is launched the first time you will need to enter the license details by clicking on **Launch License Wizard**




- Click **Next**

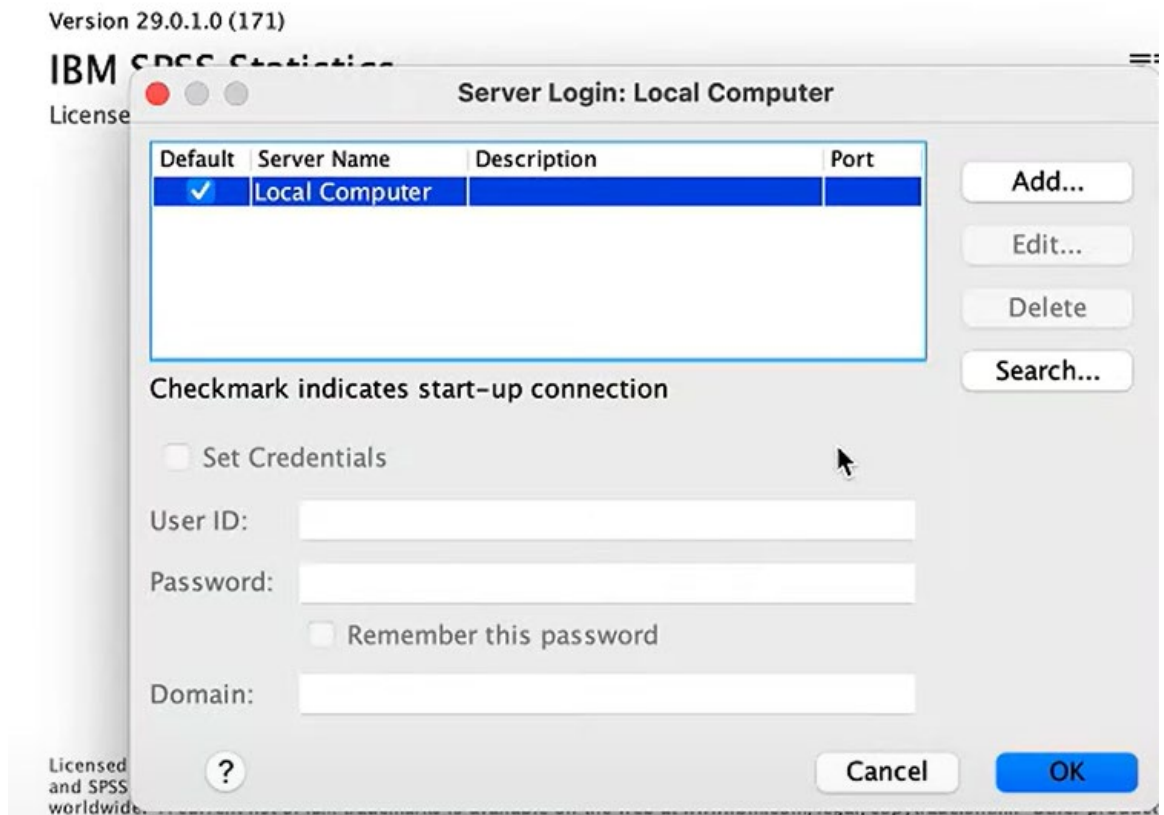
- Click on **Switch License and Restart**



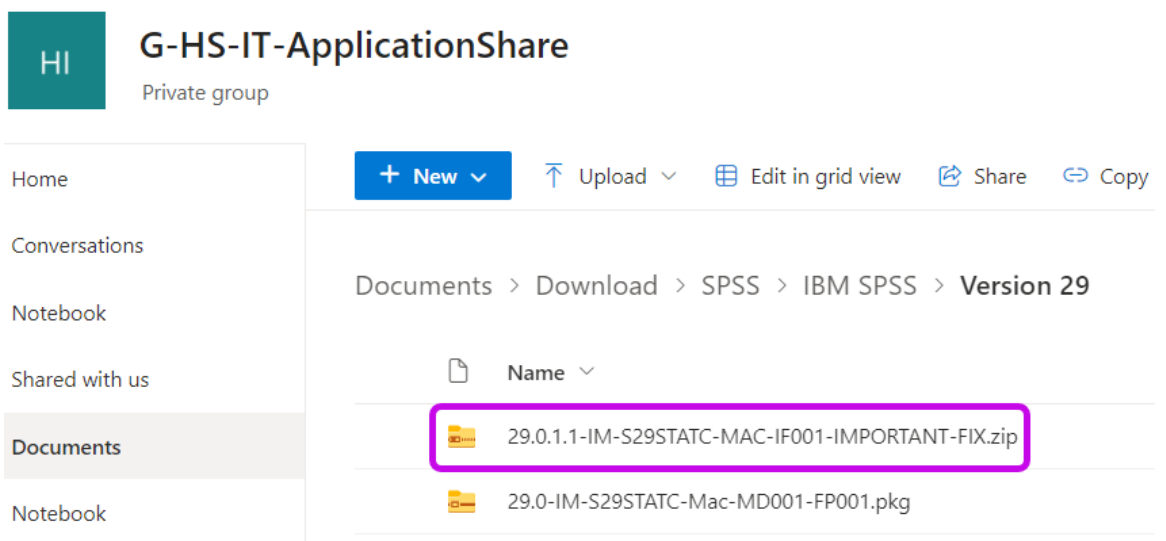
- Click on **Restart** to start SPSS. You are now ready to start using SPSS



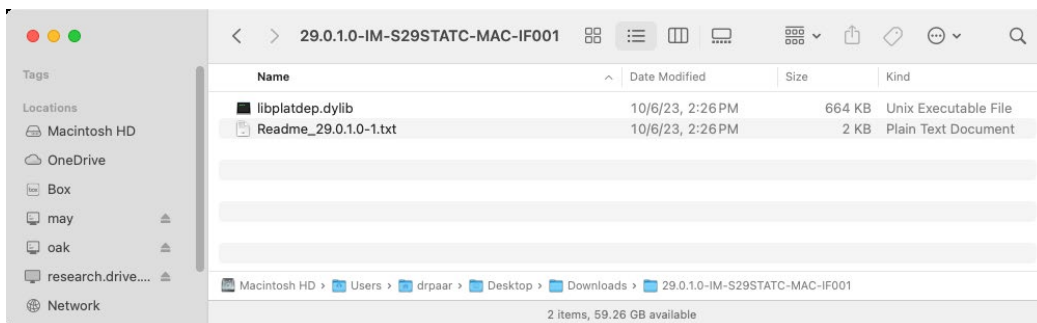
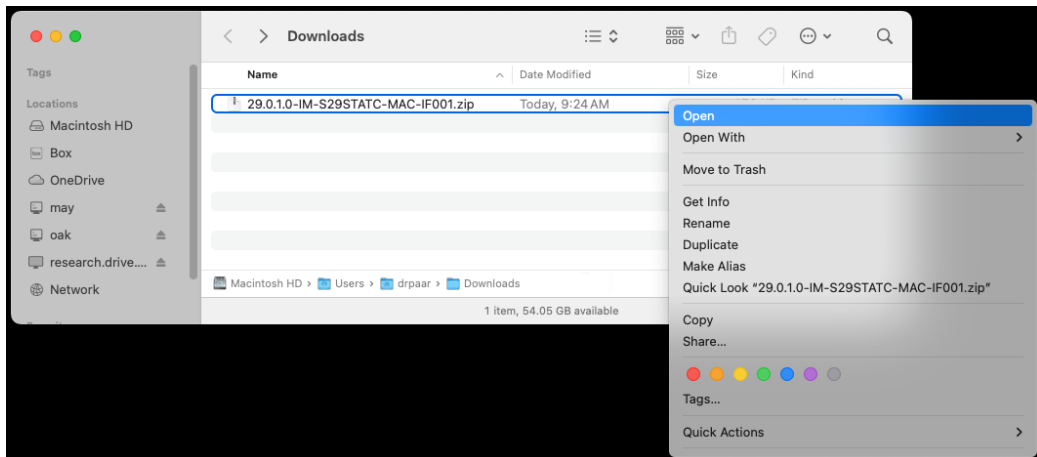
- If your Mac is running the latest MacOS (Sonoma) you will also need to install the "fixpack", otherwise the program will not run and be stuck at this windows upon startup:



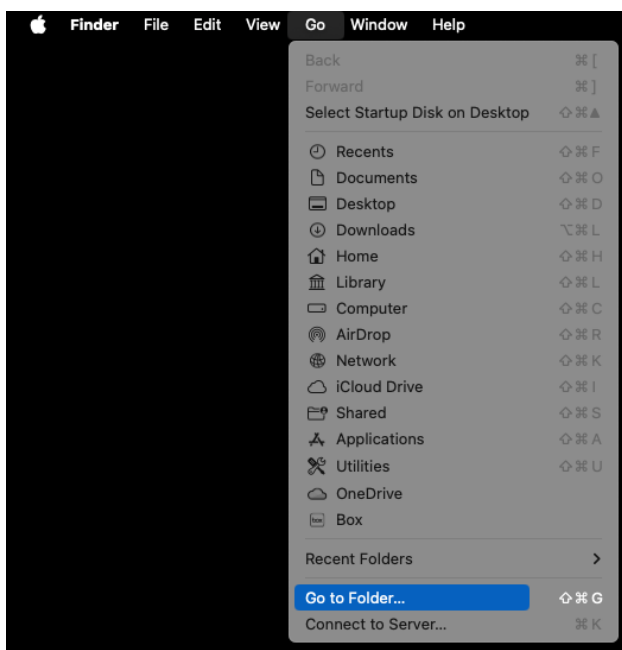
- The "Fixpack" is available from the same location that you downloaded the installation file from, go to the [Download portal again](#) (a JU account is needed for access to downloads)



- Doubleclick on the ZIP-file to see the content

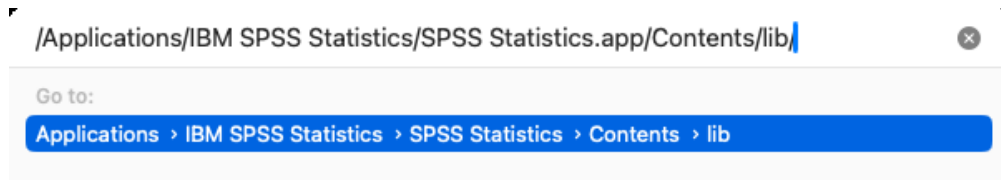


- Click on the GO-menyn and "Go to Folder...."



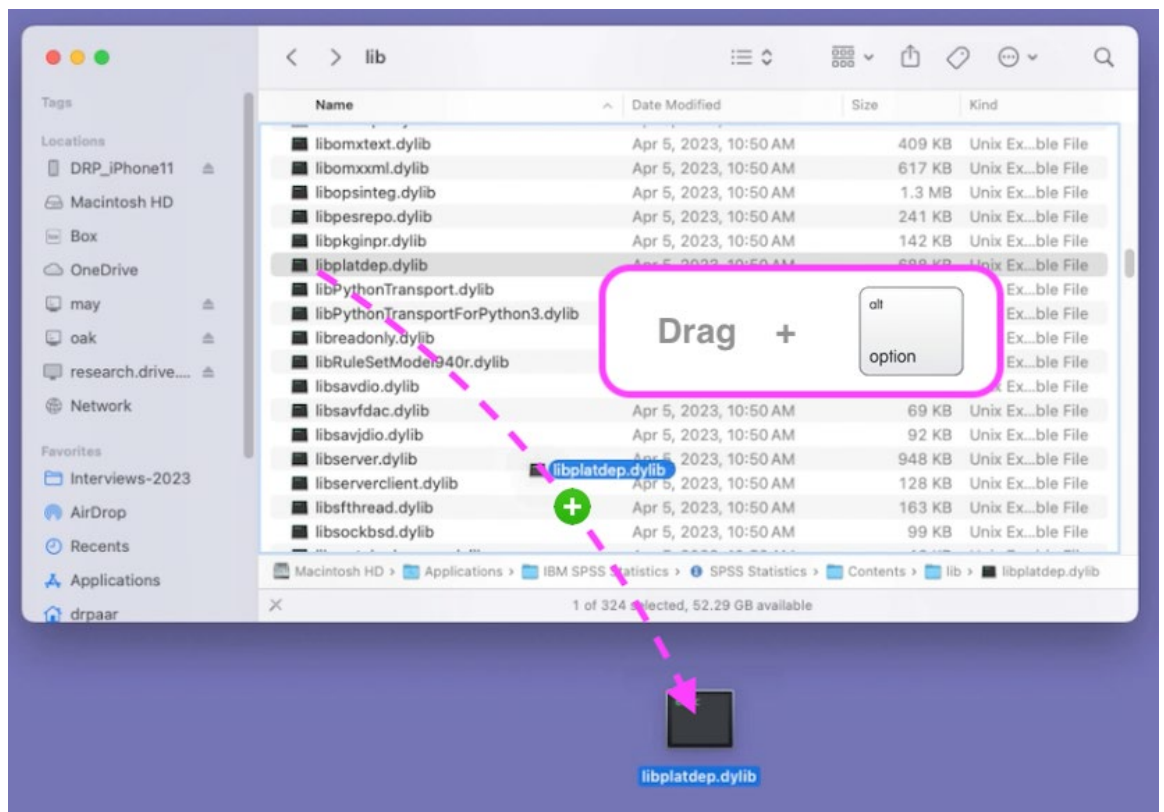
- Type in the path shown below and press the RETURN-key.

/Applications/IBM SPSS Statistics/SPSS Statistics.app/Contents/lib/



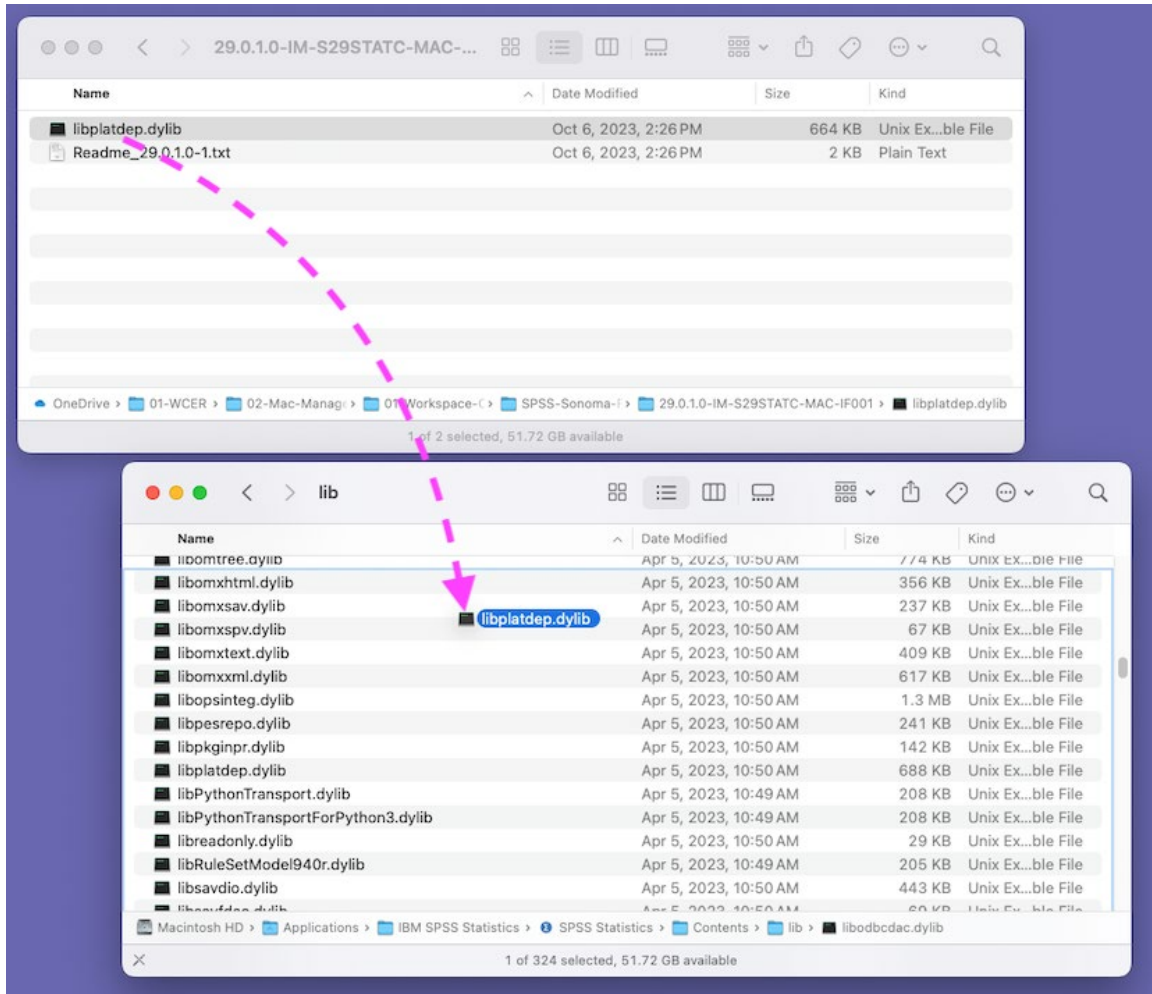
- Make a backup copy of libplatdep.dylib by holding down the OPTIONS key and dragging the libplatdep.dylib file to the Mac's Desktop.

NOTE: The cursor icon will change to show a green circle with a "+" symbol, which indicates the item is being copied.

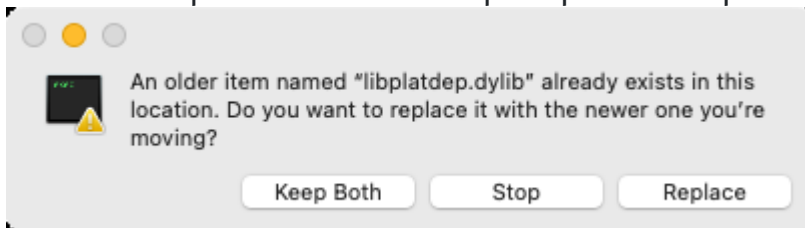


- Drag the libplatdep.dylib file from the folder that you downloaded the fixpack to earlier and drop it in the folder below:

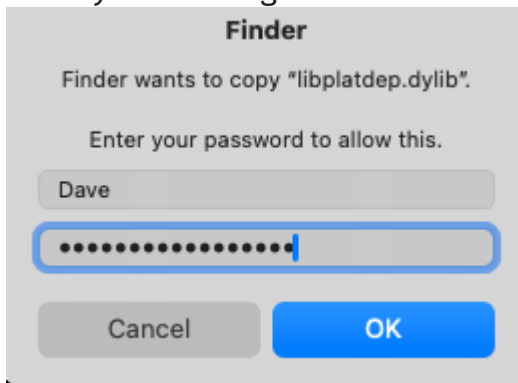
/Applications/IBM SPSS Statistics/SPSS Statistics.app/Contents/lib/



- Click the “Replace” button when prompted the replace the original file.



- Enter your Mac login credentials and click the OK button



- Make sure the installed file has the correct permissions by opening the Terminal application (/Applications/Utilities/Terminal.app) and entering the following command:

```
sudo chmod 755 /Applications/IBM\ SPSS\ Statistics/SPSS\ Statistics.app/Contents/lib/libplatdep.dylib
```

Type your Mac password when prompted and press the Return key. ^[SEP]
 NOTE: For security reasons, Terminal does not display password entries.

- If successful, the Terminal will just display a % with no message



- The fixpack is now installed and SPSS should run as normal.
