Intended Learning Outcomes (ILO)

After completing the course students are expected to:

Knowledge and understanding

- have a basic knowledge of Swedish grammar, vocabulary and everyday phrases
- have a basic knowledge of Swedish society and culture

Skills and abilities

- have sufficient language skills and general "know-how" to understand and make themselves understood in situations occurring in daily life in Sweden

- be able to improve their vocabulary and grammar by using adequate strategies

Judgement and approach

- be able to find further information in relevant subject areas and to critically evaluate that information

Type of instruction

Lessons of Swedish language. Lectures in English held by different experts of the topics. Active participation required.

The teaching is conducted in English.

Prerequisites

General requirements and English Course B (English studies at upper secondary (high school) level in Sweden). Exemption is granted from the requirement in Swedish.

Examination and grades

The course is graded Fail (U), Pass (G) or Pass with Distinction (VG).

Written individual examination of both parts of the course. Compulsory attendance. The grade is translated to the ECTS grading scale (A, B, C, D, E, Fx or F).
